## 1. AUGUST/SEPTEMBER MISSIONARY OUTREACHES

The following are the missionary outreaches for the months of August and September 2006. This information is primarily for the purpose of prayers, which every fellowship is encouraged to deliberately make arrangement for.

### (a) UNITED KINGDOM (August 10<sup>th</sup> - Sept 5<sup>th</sup> 2006)

A Missionary Outreach for East London, is scheduled to come up between August 18<sup>th</sup> - 27<sup>th</sup> 2006, although the team will arrive UK a week before the scheduled period of outreach and a week after.

The outreach is to the effect that the gospel of the Kingdom of our Lord Jesus Christ, might be proclaimed in East London; and indeed the entire United Kingdom.

Ministries will also go forth to the brethren across UK.

Brothers Kola Adegoke and Sola Ajayi will provide Ministries during the period.

### (b) TOGO INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE (August 23<sup>rd</sup> - 27<sup>th</sup> 2006)

An International Conference is scheduled to hold in Togo, between August 23<sup>rd</sup> - 27<sup>th</sup> 2006. It is at the instance and inspiration of the Lord to our Togo brethren. Brethren will partake of the conference from Nigeria, Ghana, Benin Republic and Cote D'ivoire.

Brothers Tim Abogunrin, Johnny Omodu, Ade Oyefusi, Charles Anyakwo and Johnson Egielawa will represent the Nigerian brethren to provide ministries at the Conference.

Such brethren will pay a subsidized fee of N15,000.00 each (covers transportation to Togo and return to Lagos + Feeding + Accommodation).

SIERRA LEONE MINISTRY VISIT (AUG 29<sup>TH</sup> - SEPT. 18<sup>TH</sup> 2006) The Sierra Leone Ministry visit is to achieve 2 main purposes:-

(i) Visit the young and Growing fellowships in Freetown and encourage their hearts in the Lord through inspired ministries.

(ii) Prepare towards a major outreach to Four-Bay College, Freetown (the oldest University in West Africa), which comes up in Nov/Dec 2006. Brothers Hope Ovwah and Richard Iyoha are expected to be in the Team.
